AI Disclosure Statement

To promote transparency and recognize responsible innovation, applicants are asked to disclose any use of artificial intelligence (AI) in the preparation of this award submission. An example of this is the addition of furnishings to an otherwise empty space.

The use of AI for the planning, design, construction, marketing, or operations of the physical project is outside the scope of the PRISM Awards.

Disclosure of AI use will **not** positively or negatively affect judging. Rather, it helps the judges understand how AI contributed to the project and distinguish between human expertise and AI-assisted processes.

Applicants should briefly describe:

- The AI tool(s) used (if applicable).
- How AI was used during the project or in preparing the submission.
- The extent to which AI-generated content, images, designs, analyses, or written materials were reviewed, edited, or approved by the applicant.

Applicants remain solely responsible for the accuracy, originality, and integrity of all materials submitted. By submitting an entry, the applicant certifies that all information is truthful, that any required permissions have been obtained, and that any AI-generated content complies with applicable laws, intellectual property requirements, and the PRISM Awards program rules.
